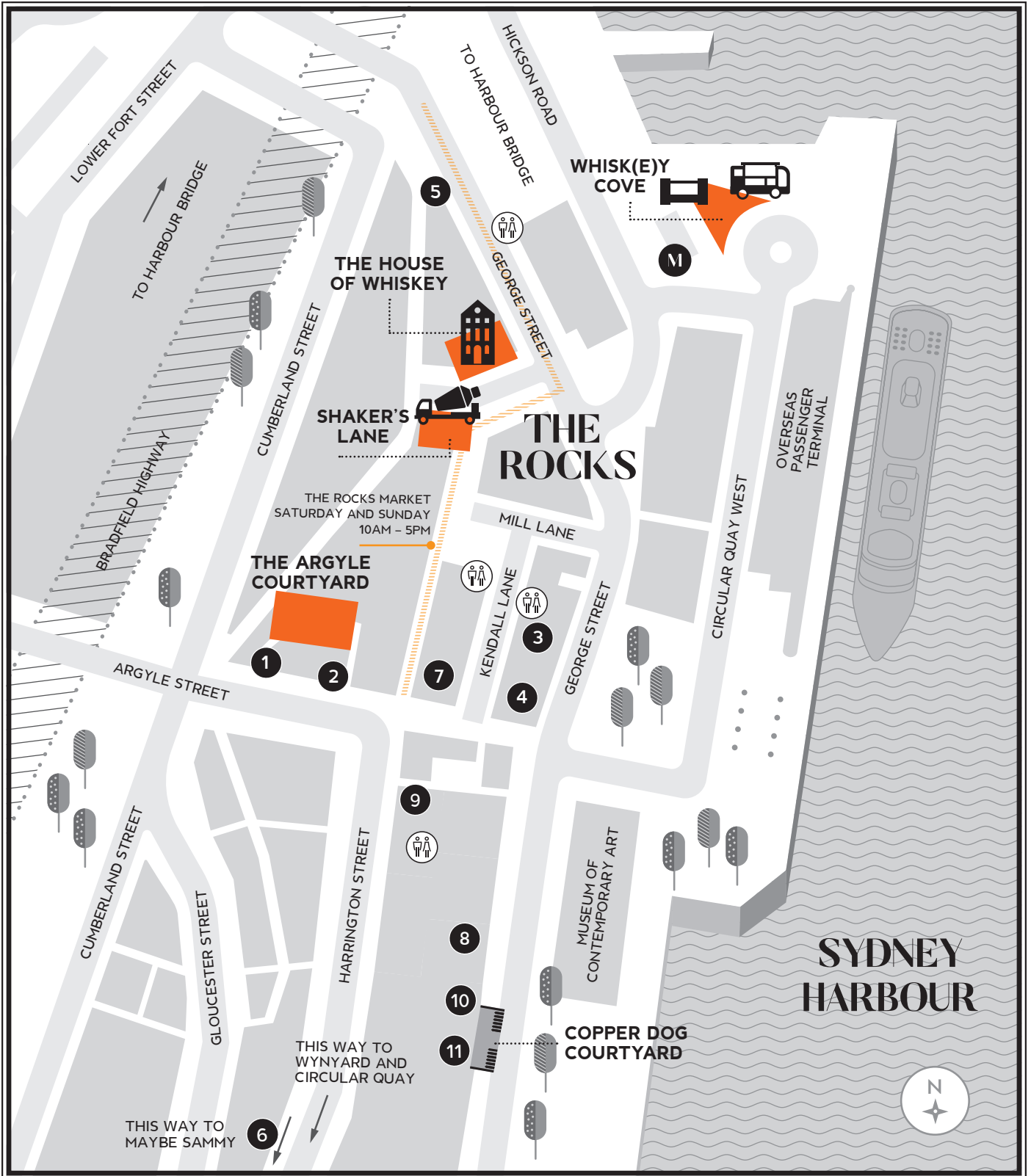

Recommended dwell time: 20 minutes

Nestled in the Argyle courtyard will be the Johnnie Walker Highball experience. Where whisky meets alfresco, serving up refreshing tasting drinks that are surprisingly delicious.

THE HOUSE OF WHISKEY

47 George & 6-8 Atherden Street

Recommended dwell time: 40 minutes (approx. 10 minutes per floor)

The House of Whiskey is split across three floors, where visitors will be invited to sample and sip as they learn about the history and craftsmanship of Maker's Mark, head upstairs to experience Dead Rabbit's old Irish Whisky bar, and complete their visit by finding the Wild Turkey 'Master's Keep Bar' in the 2nd story loft.

SHAKER'S LANE

Playfair Street

Recommended dwell time: 20 minutes

Discover Australia's largest mobile bar from Monkey Shoulder on Playfair Street. Sydneysiders won't be able to miss the iconic orange of Monkey Shoulder's high energy Monkey Mixer – a giant cocktail shaker on wheels delivering 'Made For Mixing' cocktails combined with pumping DJ tunes.

THE WHISK(E)Y TRAIL

After you have completed your 2 hour session within the ticketed areas, keep the good times rolling by joining the The Rocks Whisk(e)y Trail and sip, taste and explore your way through some of Sydney's best bars, pubs and restaurants. You do not need a festival ticket to experience the Whisk(e)y Trail and you can explore in any order you may like, as many times as you would like over the four days!

1. **SAKE** – Vibrant, rustic-chic dining room serving inventive sushi and sashimi, plus clever cocktails. Bookings needed!
2. **THE ARGYLE** – Includes a series of unique bars spread over two levels serving up bistro food and a large drinks list.
3. **THE DOSS HOUSE** – An intimate, heritage underground bar with a stylish vintage interior, allowing you to easily feel transported back to another time.
4. **MRS JONES BAR – THE ORIENT** – Take the stairs to the first floor of the Orient Hotel & you've found Mrs. Jones – a modern cocktail and terrace bar above one of the city's oldest pubs.
5. **THE MERCANTILE** – Sydney's oldest Irish pub and a must visit for a Whisk(e)y and a guinness!
6. **MAYBE SAMMY** – A 1950s Hollywood Glamour inspired interior serving up theatrical cocktails.
7. **PONY DINING** – A laneway lounge bar and a cosy wood-fire grill restaurant in one.
8. **SERGEANT LOK** – A unique Modern Asian dining and drinking destination located within the heritage-listed old police station building.
9. **TAYIM** – Modern meets traditional at Tayim, the stylish Middle Eastern fusion restaurant with stunning sandstone interiors.
10. **FORTUNE OF WAR** – Sydney's oldest pub, restored to retain its old world charm and character.
11. **THE PUSH – COPPER DOG COURTYARD** – Looking for the ultimate place to sit back, enjoy a refreshing beverage while listening to some live entertainment? The Copper Dog Courtyard is the place to be. Enjoy the expanded courtyard on George street while it lasts!
